- Fellowship with God enables us to experience the reality and intimacy of this
- Enables us to come into the throne room
- Guarantee of our inheritance



Salvation

Ongoing work:

- Enables us to come into the throne room
- Bears witness to our adoption in our hearts
- Assurance of our salvation
- Reveals God to us His character, His ways
- Will continually point us to Jesus
- Opens up His Word He is the author
 - Word is the sword of the Spirit
- Reminds us of His Word when needed

Salvation

Sanctifying work:

- He has a primary agenda to transform us

Called / destined:

- To be holy and blameless

Baptism of the Spirit

- A 'second' experience of the Holy Spirit coming on us infilling
- Is a more conscious experience (evidence of infilling)
- An initial infilling of the Spirit to empower us
 - For the good works prepared for us
- Are given a measure of the Spirit (and of faith)
- Empowered to be witnesses for Jesus
- Empowered to preach the gospel
- Gives gifts (probably irrevocable)
 - For the purpose of building up the church
 - And to aid in preaching the gospel
- He also creates opportunities
 - For us to be witnesses of Jesus
 - And tells us what to do in those moments
