Begin with God:

- Every day, every circumstance
 - Is a creative moment in God
- His intent toward us is always good
 - It is His will to bless us
 - He takes the initiative in that

- · Will see what He is doing
- Will work out our salvation in that context



Begin with God:

- He is working...
 - To reveal Himself and His ways
 - To strengthen us in every situation
 - To provide for us in every situation
 - To bring us through
 - To deliver us
 - To mature our faith
 - To transform us



What are the stories we tell about?

- Do they begin with God?
- Or do they begin with ourselves?
- Are they about His light shining on us?
- Or are they about the 'darkness'?
 - The 'mountain' in or lives
 - The shadow that casts in our lives



2 Corinthians 4:4 – the God of this world works to blind us to the light

- He cannot stop the light from shining
- He will try to take our focus off the light
- Try to get us to put it on ourselves and our difficulties



If we are honest:

- We often like to talk about how big the mountain is
- How dark the shadow is
- How far that falls in our life
- How hard that is for us



If we lose focus of the light:

- We don't begin with God
- We don't see His creative work in us
- Don't see Him working to bring about His will and His good pleasure



If we keep our focus of Him and His light:

- · We can / do begin with God
- We will see His creative work in us
- We will see Him working to bring about His will and His good pleasure
- · And we can work with Him...
- We can see His blessing



When the stories we tell begin with God

- They will be about how his light shone on us
- How His light is shining on the 'mountain'
- How the shadow is there because there is light



When the stories we tell begin with God

- They are a testimony to:
 - God working in us
 - God working for us
- We can reflect His light in those stories
- This is an attitude / act of worship
